Agenda item: Opening Presenter: Amparo Faustino

AF welcomes the attendees.

Agenda item: <u>President Report</u> Presenter: Amparo Faustino

Discussion:

The congress went back to face to face. The School in Brixen started again. ESP was legalised. The ESP affiliated to the IUPB. We supported several initiatives (including Granada School, support for LASP members, Workshop in honour of Martin Chalfie. The Journal passed publisher and the Editor in Chief was replaced (KP for RT). The Congress in Lyon was also organised and is running. Questions? None from the audience.

Agenda item: <u>Treasurer report</u> Presenter: Giorgia Miolo

Discussion:

GM presents the funds that the Society hold (funds and investment). Gives overview of the expenses (e.g., School, Scholarships etc) and a brief overview of the incomes (Congress and membership). Advises that the investments did not go well because of the global situation (lost money, but that would only translate in a loss if we sold the bonds now, which we do not foresee we will do). We will closely monitor the situation and reconsider investment portfolio to minimise the risk. Following from a comment at the AGM in Salzburg, we ensured that the investments are ethical. Questions from the audience? AF advises that the auditors will provide more details KB: recommends a diversification of the investment, this will partially go towards minimisation of the risk. The Auditors found no irregularities and this is shown on the report (shown to the attendees). The report is approved.

Agenda item: <u>ETC</u> Presenter: Massimo Trotta

Discussion:

This morning we awarded the YIA, both gave lectures earlier in the day. One of the two last awardees (ALB) received medal this morning, the other (AB) is presented with the prize now. We received applications. MT calls for applications. MT shows a break-out of the fellowship applications and award (all were awarded). This is an activity the Society is happy to engage with because it is an investment in the future of the discipline. GJA was awarded to JPG for a visit to Salvo Sortino in Catania (3 months). We awarded four ESP supplement to the PhD.

Agenda item: Santi Nonell Presenter: Santi Nonell

Discussion:

School restarted successfully (43 students from 13 countries). Many activities (social and academic). The ESP is happy to invest in this activity. We organised lectures and workshop for the future of photobiology. There is an exam. Social events included reception and hikes. The programme was reorganised and distributed in 6 areas (mapping those of the congress). All students received a certificate. The edition of 2024 is already being organised (date defined). SN gives credit to the creator of the school who is still supporting the works.

Agenda item: ESP2hD award Presenter: Virginie Lhiaubet

Discussion:

We received 7 applications, divided according to the field of study and selected a panel (one of the YIA is included). The level of the application was really high and it was challenging to select the best ones. Two awardees were selected. Miriam Izzo is not here. Carla Arnau is attending and is presented with the award. Miriam's prize is presented to the supervisor.

Agenda item: <u>Preliminary report on the 20th congress</u> **Presenter:** Thierry Douki Discussion:

TD gives an overview of the current figures. The congress is very well attended notwithstanding the difficulties of transport. Attendees come mostly from Europe (France, UK, Spain, Italy). A strong community is attending from South America, but participation is worldwide. Numbers/types of contributions is shown. Flash presentations were introduced and were a success. 30 thematic symposia. Two further activities were introduced: EU round table (funding) and a session from the publisher of PPS. TD shows the distribution of contributions across the fields. Some fields attract more than other. TD expresses satisfaction for the outcome of the congress. TD thanks the ESP and the organisers (especially Clara).

Discussion:

The most important platform is the website, but Twitter (now X) is also taking off. We have many followers and invites people to use it.

Agenda item: Photochemical and Photobiological Sciences Presenter: RT and KP

Discussion:

RT: the main event was the change of the editor in chief (now KP). The transition is still in progress. RT praises the dedication of KP and thanks the associate editors. KP thanks RT for the mentoring and support during the transition phase. The journal is a main pillar for the society. Attendees thank RT. KP introduces 4 new associated editors: Louis Arnaut, Carlos Mentz, Reza Ghiladi and Pal Selbo.

RT shows the submission numbers. Less submissions but the quality has improved. Less manuscripts are rejected before going out for review. RT gives an overview of the Topical Collections (reminds audience of what these are and why they are good for the journal). 3 new topical collections are started. KP calls for ideas and suggestions from members.
